SAN ANTONIO, TX., (April 6, 2024) – On April 6th, Aquatica, Texas' Best Waterpark, announced the grand opening of Tikitapu Splash, a 15,000 square-foot multi-level water playground. With over 100 brand-new spray-and-play elements, four exhilarating slides, and three colossal waterdumping buckets, this attraction is set to redefine aquatic fun in 2024.

The park held a grand opening ceremony that included Aquatica Park President Jodi Davenport and Vice President David Skelton taking the 'first splash' down one of Tikitapu's water slides... while clothed in their business attire! Bubbles filled the air as children from the community joined in on the fun by dumping buckets of water on the Aquatica executives as they passed under the play area's second story.

Keeping in line with Aquatica's tropical oasis theme inspired by the Māori culture of New Zealand, Tikitapu Splash takes its name from Lake Tikitapu - also known as Blue Lake - one of four lakes found in the Bay of Plenty Region of New Zealand's North Island. The name Tikitapu finds its origins in Māori history, being a sacred necklace believed to have been lost in the lake by the daughter of a high-ranking chief.

Located adjacent to Whanau Waters, a series of shallow water pools, Tikitapu Splash is the perfect new addition for children, allowing them cool relief from the hot sun, dozens of kid-friendly play elements, and gently introduces them to their first water slide experience. Covering over 15,000 square feet with its whimsical theming and a seemingly endless sea of fun, Tikitapu Splash is a towering rain fortress bursting with color, excitement, and adventures. The multi-level play area features:

- Three giant buckets, each dumping over 1325 gallons of water, creating refreshing moments for those below.
- Four exciting water slides designed for thrill-seekers of all ages.
- A spectacular array of over 100 new spray and play elements, including geysers, colorful water cannons, and gushing waterspouts.

Aquatica offers everything from the serene to the extreme with places to relax and soak in the sun, thrilling waterslides and rides, and one-of-a-kind opportunities to experience incredible animal interactions. Known for its resort-like atmosphere, Aquatica has relaxing pools scattered throughout the park and plenty of shaded cabanas and loungers for guests to decompress and unwind.
