

SeaWorld San Diego's Inside Look Event Expands to Two Weekends with ALL-NEW Exclusive Behind-the-Scenes Access and Educational Experiences

Taking place January 11-12 and 18-20, the event features new activations including an exclusive preview of the park's new Jellyfish Experience opening Spring 2025

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SAN DIEGO, CA (January 7, 2025) – SeaWorld San Diego's Inside Look returns and is bigger than ever, expanding to two weekends of exclusive behind-the-scenes access and inspiring educational experiences. Taking place from January 11 – January 12 and January 18 – January 20, the highly anticipated event invites guests to connect with SeaWorld animal care specialists, hear their personal stories about caring for the park's animals and discover fascinating facts about the animals and their species. This year, guests can look forward to three new activations, including an exclusive aquarist talk previewing our moon jellies who will part of the all-new Jewels of the Sea: The Jellyfish Experience. This immersive aquarium opening in Spring 2025 is our first standalone animal exhibit in over a decade. Visitors of Inside Look will also enjoy special access to areas of the park that are normally not open to the public, including the SeaWorld Rescue Center.

Included with park admission, Inside Look brings all-new exclusive experiences and returning fan favorites to the program this year including:

ALL-NEW Jewels of the Sea – Aquarist Talk – Discover the fascinating world of Moon Jellies in a Kreisel display designed to showcase their beauty and elegance, located at the new Jellyfish Plaza just outside Jewels of the Sea: The Jellyfish Experience, the all-new immersive aquarium opening in Spring 2025.

ALL-NEW Let's Learn About Whales! – This presentation is geared for children of all ages who love whales and want to learn more about them. Join us at the Rescue Jr. stage for a fun,

interactive program! Discover how whales and humans are alike, how they swim, the differences between toothed and baleen whales, and just how big they can be.

ALL-NEW Otter Trainer Talk – View our sea otter nursery during our Otter Trainer Talk at Wild Artic. Learn about our California sea otters and the history of SeaWorld San Diego's rehabilitation of these playful sea otters.

Inside the SeaWorld Rescue Center – From 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m., guests will have the very special opportunity to tour areas of SeaWorld Rescue Center, a back area of the park where the Rescue Team brings hundreds of rescued animals each year for rehabilitation. During this coveted experience, guests will meet and hear from the dedicated animal care personnel, lab technicians, and veterinarians who work around the clock to deliver life-saving care to animals in need.

Beluga Trainer Talk – Explore the world of beluga whales during our Beluga Trainer Talk at Wild Arctic. Learn about our team's dedication to the well-being of these majestic creatures and the park's commitment through engaging discussions and demonstrations.

Penguin Keeper Talk – Get a look at the fascinating lives of penguins during our Penguin Keeper Talk at Penguin Encounter! Here guests will discover the adaptive traits of these birds, their social dynamics, and the park's commitment to the conservation of penguin species and their habitats in the wild.

Inside Turtle Reef – Watch zoological scuba divers interact with turtles in the reef while educators share information, answer questions, and engage guests with fun games like Rock-Paper-Scissors.

Feathers, Scales, and Furry Tails – Located at Mission Bay Theater. This fun and educational presentation shares the story of Conservation Ambassadors, animal care, and rescue. Guests will learn and see animals ranging from alligators, capybaras, owls and more!

Inside Look Connections – Join us from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. as we spotlight conservation organizations in the local community at SkyTower Lawn. Organizations such as Hubbs-SeaWorld Research Institute, Project Wildlife, Living Coast Discovery Center, Helen Woodward Animal Care Center, as well as SeaWorld Rescue, will have booths where guests can ask questions and learn about their important work.

To further enhance their Inside Look experience, guests can pick up an Inside Look passport at the front of the park and visit certain Inside Look locations for a special stamp. Once complete, bring the completed passport back to The Whale Shop to receive a special prize (while supplies last).
