## INSTRUCTIONAL FIELD TRIP (San Diego County)

*A minimum of 10 paying participants is required for the Field Trip program.*

**Please fill out this worksheet to determine the total cost of your program.**

### Payments

- **Credit Card, Purchase Orders or Checks** (with I.D.) are preferred.
- **The entire park, including the field trip register, is now cashless.** Please prepare accordingly.
- **ONE form of payment per school**
- No refunds. All payments are final.
- All participants pay, including: *Teachers, Chaperones and Children over three* enrolled in your school.

### Passes

- Collect all **SeaWorld Passes / Fun Cards** before the check-in process.
- Separate all passes into "Adult" and "Child" bundles.
- Field Trip Program admission may not be used towards *SeaWorld Pass or Fun Card* purchase.

### Ratios

- **First to 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Ratio** – **minimum 1:10** (one adult/ten students) **maximum 1:3** (one adult/three students)
- **Preschool, Kindergarten, Home School and Special Education Ratio** – **1:1** (one adult/one student).
- Extra adults and children above the ratio are offered a *20% discount* off regular park admission.

# Important Field Trip Information

*Please review this information carefully*

## Parking

- Display Parking Placard to receive complimentary parking in H2 lot, follow map directions to bypass tolls. Refunds for toll payments cannot be made.
- Teachers may make copies to accommodate additional drivers. Placard not required for busses.

## Security

- **Do Not Bring:** Hard-sided coolers, straight pins, balloons, glass containers, plastic bags, weapons, straws, headphones, or shoes with wheels.
- All bags are subject to search.

## Field Trip Program

- Program includes one show, either the Sea Lion and Otter Presentation or the Dolphin Presentation, and self-guided exploration of animal habitats. Please check SeaWorld.com for showtimes.
- Guides and maps are available on SeaWorld.com/Education Programs and School Field Trip button.
- Students sitting in wet sections of amphitheaters must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.

## Stay & Play All-Day Program

- For an additional fee, guests can stay to enjoy SeaWorld shows, rides, and *Rescue Jr.* Guests must have the **Stay & Play Wristband** to be admitted to these areas.
- All students must have an adult chaperone accompanying them on rides.
- Height restrictions apply for rides.
- Middle and high school students are not allowed entrance to *Rescue Jr.* playground.

## Lunches

- Lunch storage is no longer available, each person may bring in individual lunches.
- Help us keep our environment clean! Ask your group to use the trash receptacles and recycling bins.

## After Entering the Park

- After you enter the park, explore SeaWorld animal habitats and attend the show of your choice.
- Educators are available at the animal areas to answer student questions.
- Only participants with *pre-purchased Stay & Play Wristband* are permitted in public shows or rides.
- Students must be chaperoned at all times.
- Please adhere to all school behavior and dress codes.
- Conduct problems are referred to SeaWorld Security Department and reported to school principals.
- Wheelchairs are available to rent at the Main Entrance. A chaperone may pay and pick it up on arrival.
