

SEAWORLD SLEEPOVER PARENT/CHAPERONE INFORMATION

ARRIVAL: 5:45 p.m.—Adventure Camp Entrance-- See map on next page for directions. Please arrive on time, entrance doors will close as soon as check-in is completed and no one will be admitted after 6:00 p.m. If unexpected delays arise the night of your Sleepover please call (619) 226-3900 ext 4379 by 5:30 p.m. to make arrangements with our staff.

*All Sleepover participants will be entering and exiting through the Adventure Camp facility during the Sleepover program. There is no re-entry at this building once your program is over. See SeaWorld staff at dismissal for details on park re-entry during the day.

<u>MEALS:</u> Pre-planned dinner and breakfast are included in the Sleepover package. Make sure your group leader is aware of any special dietary needs or allergies to include in the roster sent to SeaWorld staff so we can make accommodations if needed.

LUGGAGE: SeaWorld Security may search bags prior to entry. Plan to store your luggage in your vehicle at 8:00 a.m. the day after your Sleepover event.

BEDTIME: Dependent upon park hours and activities. Your group's bedtime may be as late as midnight during certain times of the year.

SAFETY: Shirts and shoes are required at all times before bedtime. Sleepovers are a fully supervised event and members of the SeaWorld Sleepover Team will remain with the group throughout the event. Please be aware that there is a lot of walking involved in this event. Adults and children are required to stay with their groups at all times, and follow all directions from SeaWorld employees. SeaWorld Security and Health Services are on duty 24 hours a day.

ALCOHOL: No outside alcohol is permitted on SeaWorld property, including the SeaWorld parking lot. No alcohol consumption is permitted during the Sleepover program; refer to the Code of Conduct below. Chaperones should be prepared to perform chaperone duties in a responsible fashion.

<u>DISMISSAL</u>: When SeaWorld opens the following day, participants will be released to enjoy the day in the park on their own. Our staff will not have contact with the Sleepover group after dismissal. Any additional guests planning to join your group in the park for the day are responsible for their own parking and admission.

<u>PARENTS & CHAPERONES:</u> Due to the nature of our program and the age of the participants, SeaWorld Staff are unable to give out specific information pertaining to any Sleepover. This includes, but is not limited to, cancellations, substitutions, and persons attending the Sleepover. The SeaWorld Sleepover team will happily answer any general questions you may have about sleepovers, but for specific information refer to your group leader.

<u>CODE OF CONDUCT:</u> All participants are expected to act in a responsible and courteous manner at all times. Upon arrival to the program, SeaWorld staff will review examples of acceptable and unacceptable behavior. If a behavior problem arises, the staff will first discuss the problem with the individual. If the problem continues or is severe, SeaWorld Security officers may be asked to intervene. Finally, if the problem is not rectified, the participant may be removed from the program. Adult participants are responsible for providing their own transportation and a refund will not be issued.

Examples of behavior that may result in a participant being removed from the program include, but are not limited to, consumption or possession of alcohol (including in parking lots); use or possession of tobacco products (including e-cigarettes) or illegal narcotics; possession of a weapon (real or look-a-like); destruction of property; stealing; separating from the group during program hours; and entering the sleeping area of the opposite gender.



SEAWORLD SLEEPOVER PARKING DIRECTIONS

From Interstate 5

- Exit SeaWorld Drive
- Drive past the main SeaWorld entrance (do not turn into SeaWorld)
- Just past the main SeaWorld entrance bear right onto Ingraham Street
- Turn right at the first stop light—Perez Cove Way—and bear right
- Follow signs to SeaWorld


From Interstate 8

- Exit at Mission Bay Drive/Sports Arena Blvd
- Turn right at the stoplight at the end of off-ramp (you will be heading north on Ingraham Street)
- DO NOT veer right onto SeaWorld Drive
- Turn right at the first stop light—Perez Cove Way
- Follow signs to SeaWorld

From surface streets

- Use Ingraham Street to get to Perez Cove Way
- Turn east on Perez Cove Way
- Follow signs to SeaWorld

Go past the "Administration/Deliveries" road (Security entrance) on your left then turn left into the employee parking lot. Park in any available space (except those labeled Security). Buses should keep going to the right of the Adventure Camp building and park in any available RV parking spot. Continue on foot to the Adventure Camp Facility, (labeled Camp Dorms on the map below). Checkin begins at 5:45PM in front of the glass doors.
